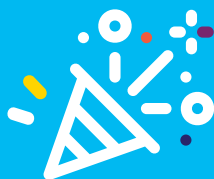

Public universities



Universidad de Buenos Aires.

Created in 1821, The University of Buenos Aires is one of the most important public further education institutions in Latin America. With more than 300,000 undergraduate and postgraduate students, the university is a national and international point of reference for teaching, professional training, investigation and academic extension. Its faculties have trained five Nobel Prize winners: Carlos Saavedra Lamas (Peace Prize, 1936), Bernardo Alberto Houssay (Medicine, 1947), Luis Federico Leloir (Chemistry, 1970), Adolfo Pérez Esquivel (Peace, 1980), and César Milstein (Medicine, 1984). Today, its community comprises 31,528 teachers and lecturers, 291,744 undergraduate students, 26,503 postgraduate students, 5,900 secondary school students, 15,000 non-teaching staff, 8,800 investigators, 2,300 scholarship students and 2,700 investigation projects.

It has 13 faculties, 5 institutions of secondary education with commercial, agricultural and technical orientations, 17 institutes of investigation of its own, and 37 shared with CONICET; 6 teaching hospitals, 14 museums, a cultural centre, ballet, cinema, radio station, choir and orchestra.

The UBA works intensely to strengthen and consolidate the university's internationalisation, promoting academic, scientific and cultural exchanges on one side, and social and cultural integration within the university community on the other. In accordance with these goals, the International Relations Office has developed a comprehensive policy of internationalisation, implemented through diverse actions:

- > Cooperation through agreements in areas of common interest with other further education institutions that offer a high level of academic excellence.

CELU exam

What is it?

The Certificate in Spanish Language and Use (Certificado de Español Lengua y Uso – CELU) is an official qualification granted by a group of 35 Argentine universities and recognised by Argentina's Ministry of Education and Ministry of Foreign Relations and Culture.

How do I obtain the qualification?

The qualification is obtained through an examination that assesses speakers of Spanish as a foreign language in their ability to communicate orally and in writing within social, professional and academic contexts.

Levels

→ Intermediate level

users can express themselves in oral and written Spanish with certain fluidity and naturalness in

simple family, social and professional situations. The speaker can also begin undergraduate university courses. This level is comparable with level “B2” of the Common European Framework of Reference and “Intermediate Low” of the American Council on the Teaching of Foreign Languages.

→ Advanced level

users can express themselves comfortably, spontaneously, accurately and appropriately in oral and written Spanish in a wide range of social, professional and academic situations. This level is comparable with level “C1” of the Common European Framework of Reference and “Superior” of the American Council on the Teaching of Foreign Languages.

Validity

The CELU qualification can be used as proof of Spanish language competency for academic institutions, and public and private companies. At an international level, the qualification is recognised by the governments of Brazil, China and Italy.

The visa

Argentina has international working holiday agreements with Australia, Denmark, France, Germany, Ireland, Norway and New Zealand, which allow young people aged up to 30 years to apply for a working holiday ("Vacaciones y Trabajo") visa. The visa grants holders permission to remain in Argentina for 12 months (with no extension) and to obtain an employee identification number in order to legally work in the country without the need for any further paperwork.

Requirements (other specific requirements may apply for citizens of each participating country).

Participants must:

- Be aged between 18 and 30 (for New Zealanders, the limit is 35).
- Travel unaccompanied, unless companions have a visa.
- Have not participated in the programme before.
- Have no criminal record.
- Demonstrate sufficient funds to cover the initial costs of their stay.
- Have a reservation for return travel to their country of origin, or prove sufficient funds to purchase said journey.
- Possess medical insurance covering hospitalisation and repatriation costs.
- Pay the corresponding consular fees for the visa.
